

STATEMENT OF WORK
FOR
ALTERNATIONS, SEWING, DRY CLEANING, LAUNDRY

1. Description of Services. Furnish all supplies, labor, and equipment for alterations, sewing, dry cleaning, laundry, and embroidered name tags, for six (6) AJROTC units assigned to the Clarksville-Montgomery County School System.
2. Requirements. Vendor shall be available for service calls during normal working hours 8:00 A.M. through 5:00 P.M., Monday through Friday, with the exception of holidays. Vendor shall coordinate with the individual school point of contact as listed in determining requirements for "on-site" alterations. Vendor will be available within 24 hours of point of contact notification and the required alterations must be completed within 24 hours of pickup/drop-off. This requirement could apply to 1000 individual uniforms during the 24 hour periods at the beginning and end of each school year. Vendor is responsible for correcting deficiencies which may result from alterations at no additional cost to the Government. Under no circumstances will clothing be cut. All hems will be sewn and pressed, no tape or glue will be utilized.
3. An invoice is required for each individual uniform; depicting services performed and shall include the Contract Number, date of service, items and description of service performed, legible customer signature. Invoices shall be submitted to central point of contact CW4 (RET) David M. Taylor upon completion of services. Payment will be made on a monthly basis utilizing the US Government Impact Credit Card.
4. As listed are the authorized representatives from each of six (6) area high schools, who may contact the vendor.
